POST SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTION PROGRAM

2007-2008

Students interested in the Post Secondary Enrollment Option Program are required to file an application for acceptance into that program, provide results of either an ACT or SAT and current high school transcripts. All materials should be sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. **Continuing PSEOP participants need only submit an application.**

CRITERIA and GUIDELINES

- 1) Students must have participated in a college preparatory curriculum and have completed the following:
 - * Two or more years of high school English
 - * Two or more units of math (algebra I or higher)
 - * Two or more units of science (one must be a laboratory science)
 - * Two or more units of social studies
- 2) Cumulative grade point average of at least 3.25/4.00 at the time of application.
- 3) Composite score of 23 or higher on the ACT or a 1050 total score on the SAT (sub-scores will be used to obtain the best overall composite or total if the ACT or SAT was taken more than once.)
- 4) Applications must be postmarked no later than July 1st for the fall semester and no later than December 1st for the spring semester. **Students must submit a separate application for each semester.**
- 5) Enrollment is limited to only those courses posted for PSEOP students and the availability of those courses
- 6) Students may not register for classes before August 1st for fall semester and December 15th for spring semester.

All of the above criteria will be considered for acceptance into the PSEOP. Students who have the appropriate GPA and test scores are **not** guaranteed admission into the Post Secondary Enrollment Option Program. Acceptance into PSEOP does not guarantee course availability. Students will be notified of their enrollment status.

COST

There are two options related to the type of credit and cost of that credit at the time a student enrolls.

OPTION A: Allows a student to choose to receive post-secondary (college) credit only. Students who choose option "A" will be required to pay for the cost of tuition, textbooks, materials and fees.

OPTION B: Allows students to choose to receive post-secondary (college) and secondary credit, the cost of tuition, textbooks, materials and fees will be paid for you.
